

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORMATTING ABSTRACTS OF YOUR PRESENTATION FOR THE 14TH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON GEOMETRY AND GRAPHICS

This paper presents instructions for formatting abstracts to be submitted to the 14th International Conference in Geometry and Graphics (ICGG 2010 Kyoto). These instructions are to be strictly followed so that all papers in the proceedings have a consistent appearance. This paper itself is formatted according to the formatting rules. Use it as a model and edition template. This document is supplied as a Microsoft Word file containing preformatted styles. We basically ask authors to replace the text of *this* file with their own, preserving the formatting. All papers must be prepared in Microsoft Word or other file-compatible software using the font Times New Roman and convert it in **pdf-format** as a result. This document must contain the abstract title, authors, their affiliations, abstract and keywords. Figures and references might be included. You should prepare an abstract which correctly reflects your presentation (300 to 500 word long, maximum 2 pages including figures, English language only).

bottom margin: overhead/ underneath: 3cm --- left/right: 2cm

The style to be used in the	
<i>title</i>	is "icgg-title": TimesNewRoman, 15pt, bold, capital letters, centered, spacing: 24pt before
<i>author's names</i>	is "icgg-authors": TimesNewRoman, 12pt, bold, centered, spacing: 28pt before (in the order: given name, middle initial, family name), with family name in capital letters. Co-author names are separated by commas and the preposition "and". If authors have different affiliations, follow names with superscript numbering like the model above.)
<i>affiliations</i>	is "igcc-affiliation": TimesNewRoman, 12pt, normal, centered (If more than one, superscript numbering is placed before the institution name. After institution name, indicate country.)
<i>abstract text</i>	is "icgg-abstract": TimesNewRoman, 12pt, justified, spacing: 24pt before
<i>keywords</i>	is "icgg-keywords": TimesNewRoman, 12pt, normal, spacing: 12pt before (type from three to six keywords)
<i>references</i>	is "icgg-ref": TimesNewRoman, 12pt, justified, (spacing: 12pt before for the first item)
